

## Class 1 Spellings – Term 1

Dear Parents,

Below you will find a chart with the spellings we will be learning this term. You will notice that above each column there is the word READ or the word SPELL. This indicates the focus both at home and in school for the set of words that week.

You will notice that the first half of the term is spent learning to recognise and read each word and the second half is revisiting the words and learning to spell them. It is important that your child learns to read and write the words out of the list order. In other words, do not always start with the first word as children very quickly pick up patterns and may actually be remembering this rather than how to read/spell the word on its own.

**For the reading weeks each child will bring home a sheet of words in their homework book to read.**

**For the spelling weeks each child will bring home a sheet of words in their homework book for learning to spell.**

**Please** check your child's homework book regularly in order to keep up to date with spellings and any additional homework or home/school communication regarding your child's progress.
