Reception
Talk about the lives of people around them and their roles in our community.
Know some similarities and differences between different religious and cultural communities in this country.
Understand that some places are special to members of their community.
Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.
Talk about how people celebrate Diwali, Hannukah, and Christmas.
Use the story of Noah's Ark, to talk about how we can take responsibility, show compassion and kindness.
